The Partnership for Health Research and Training in Kenya (P-HERT) is a grant awarded to the University of Nairobi by the US National Institutes of Health. The aim of this grant is to build the capacity of Junior Faculty in the design and conduct of research with focus on HIV and AIDS, Mental Health, and Maternal Newborn & Child Health. The grant will support a 2-year Research Capacity Building Program that provides in-depth training in Research Methods.

TRAINING PROGRAM OUTLINE

- In the first year of the program, the Junior Faculty Trainees will undertake didactic and online courses at UoN and at the University of Washington to develop skills in Epidemiology, Biostatistics, Implementation

The Partnership for Health Research Training in Kenya (P-HERT) is a grant awarded to the University of Nairobi to develop and implement a two-year Research Capacity Building Program targeting Junior Faculty at the University of Nairobi, Kenyatta and Maseno Universities. The aim of this training is to foster the next generation of research scientists by developing their in-depth research skills and expertise in the fields of HIV/AIDS, Mental Health and Maternal Newborn & Child Health.

The program plans to initiate a competitive recruitment of the third group of trainees. The training is open to academic staff from the level of tutorial fellows to senior lecturers in the Health Sciences at the University.
